Writer/Director, *I Like Him*. 2021-present

A seriocomic piece in which two sisters grapple with their father's affair with a high school student and how he fits into their lives.

Living in Miami, she experiences the intrinsic guilt for the sacrifices that were made for her privilege and the shame of relating more to a culture that doesn't fully embrace her.
